How much are nj passes

NJ Public Bus, Rte #80WikipediaAs a former daily rider of NJT (New Jersey Transit) buses, I have come to the conclusion that it may be time for NJT to do some upgrades. The first upgrade that they should focus on is getting better paper for their monthly bus passes. Although this may not sound like a major issue, having cheap paper for a monthly bus pass poses a lot of problems for not only riders, but for drivers as well. The passes are printed on thin, cheap paper that can easily be ripped or water-damaged in the slightest bit of rain. The ink that is used to print the pass where they are actually printed out of a printer rather than having a card or something similar), fades out like watercolor paint that has been diluted. This may hold up bus drivers, because the passes are color-coded according to the month, and if the driver does not see the color, they have to take extra time out to inspect the pass and make sure its valid. Also, because they are so flimsy, sometimes the wind will pull them right out of your hand and you may end up running down the street chasing your pass. Also, if you laminate your bus pass to protect it, its no longer valid. Lamination is against NJT policy. What's even crazier about the bus pass issue is that the receipt that you get when you pay for your bus pass is printed out on a high-quality, card stock-type photo paper. So I'm trying to figure out why NJT thinks its more important to have a durable receipt than a durable bus pass that you use for a whole month. See how flimsy this bus pass is:Original Picture of NJT Monthly Bus PassAnother flaw that NJT has is the way that passengers use their monthly bus passes. Instead of a machine that "reads" your card, such as those that are on the MTA buses in NYC, passengers simply show their bus passes to the driver (which is why it's bad when your pass gets wet and the color fades). This system may have worked just fine a couple of decades ago, but now with everything being automated, computerized, and everyone being in such a rush, it would probably be simpler for NJT to have card readers on the bus. And since NJT has a complex "fare zone" system, which will be covered in the next paragraph, sometimes passengers travel to certain destinations without paying the full fare because most drivers can't just simply remember which zone all of their passengers' bus passes were valid for.Front view of NJT monthly bus passOriginal photo of NJT Monthly Bus PassNow we get to the complex "fare zone" system. What exactly is a fare zone? Well, depending on where a passenger is boarding the bus, a fare zone is basically the amount of money that the passenger pays for the distance that the passenger will be traveling. For example, if you have a one-zone pass, as indicated in the picture to the right by the large number 1 in the middle of the pass, that allows you to travel anywhere in the city that you are boarding the bus in. So if you are in Newark, you board the bus in Newark, and you get off in Newark, then you have only traveled in one zone and the single ride fare is \$1.50, plus an extra seventy cents for a transfer. The monthly one zone bus pass is \$54. If you board the bus in Newark, you get off in Paterson, you have traveled four zones, so the bus fare is \$3.50 plus seventy cents for a transfer. The monthly four zone pass is \$92. It doesn't matter which city you buy your bus pass in. Once you have the pass, if you board in a particular city, that's where your fare zone will start. What makes this system complex is that there are approximately thirty-nine zones in northern New Jersey. That is a lot of zones for a passenger to sort through to figure out how much money they need for the bus. And since there aren't any automatic card readers on the bus, the passengers are supposed to tell the bus driver which zone they are traveling to. So that makes things even worse for the poor bus drivers who have to try and remember that passenger who told them they were only traveling three zones, and hid in the back of the bus, and got off at zone nineteen. Because of this problem, I've seen passengers be wrongly accused of not paying the correct amount of money, as well as passengers who get away with not paying the full fare. I was a victim of being wrongfully accused of not paying the full amount when I traveled a four zone trip. I took me about five minutes to convince the driver that I had paid the correct amount. Other passengers were annoyed at the fact that the bus was being delayed and finally the driver just gave in and agreed that I'd paid the correct amount. Passengers are able to buy advanced tickets from customer service centers at select locations such as bus terminals or automatic ticket vending machines, and the tickets will have the number of zones that the passenger is traveling. However, this still does not eliminate the problem of a passenger buying a ticket for a certain amount of zones, and then traveling a different amount.Back view of NJT monthly bus passOriginal photo of NJT Monthly Bus PassThere are two really simple solutions to solve the majority of the problems that NJT bus passes create. Number one: install an automatic card reader system on the buses, and number two: change the monthly passes from flimsy paper passes to plastic cards with computer chips embedded in them, such as the SmartLink cards for NJT PATH trains (I've had my SmartLink card for a year now, very durable!). Not only will these changes save money and paper for NJT, but it will be a lot less hassle for customers and bus drivers. Questions & AnswersQuestion: How much is it for a three-zone bus pass in NJ?Answer: Visit www.njtransit.com to find current fare information.Question: How much is it for a two zone bus pass in NJ?Answer: The last price that I know of was July of 2018, and it was \$78. That is for the interstate pass only (if you want to travel to NYC, it cost a little more).Question: How can you figure out which zone is needed for your daily trip. Say Lawrenceville nj to Trenton?Answer: The NJ transit website has a feature that will allow you to input your departure location and your destination location. It will ask you what method of travel you want to take. Then it will let you know how many zones you need. You could also ask a customer service agent at a transit center.Question: In New Jersey, can you use a bus ticket (7 zone 1-way) to transfer to the train or would I have to buy another 7 Zone train ticket?Answer: Bus tickets can't be used on the train, but train tickets can be used on the bus. Daily commuters or occasional riders who transfer between SEPTA and New Jersey Transit at the Trenton Transit Center can purchase one-way tickets, round trip tickets, or monthly interagency passes. Ticket prices will vary based on your origin and destination stations. For occasional trips, joint tickets can be purchased at over 80 NJ Transit Stations, the NJ Transit Ticket Machines at Amtrak 30th Street Station, and from SEPTA Ticket Offices at Market East and Suburban Station. Customers may now also purchase joint tickets at the SEPTA 30th Street Station Ticket Office. These tickets are valid until used (no expiration date) and are non-refundable. FLEXPASS provides 20 one-way adult tickets for travel between one origin and one destination of your choice, sold at a 20% discount from full-priced tickets. Save up to 30 percent off your daily commute by purchasing a NJ TRANSIT bus pass. You can use it to make unlimited trips on NJ TRANSIT bus routes for an entire calendar month for the number of zones indicated on the pass. The intrastate pass is valid for rides between local routes within New Jersey only. The interstate pass is valid for rides between New Jersey and New York City or Philadelphia. It may also be used for local rides within New Jersey. The intracommuter pass is valid for rides on bus routes between U.S. Highways 9 & 18 from Jersey City, Weehawken, Hoboken, or Newark. Some private bus companies, many subsidized by NJ TRANSIT, will also accept the bus pass. Check with your private carrier. If you use more than one bus to reach your destination, you don't need to purchase a transfer if you have a bus pass. When you make your connection, just show your pass to the driver and you can travel up to the number of zones on the pass. Bus passes are available at most major terminals and at local outlets throughout New Jersey. At NJ TRANSIT ticket offices and Ticket Vending Machines, bus passes are available for purchase beginning at 5 p.m. on the 19th of the previous month through the 10th of the month for which the pass is valid. (At local outlets passes are sold through the 5th of the month for which they are valid.) Ten-trip tickets are valid for ten one-way trips. Some ten-trip tickets are discounted. Discounted ten-trip bus tickets are valid for 20 days. Full-fare ten-trip bus tickets are valid until used. Valid for intrastate travel on bus routes 156R, 158 and 159R (two zones), the Hudson-Bergen Light Rail system, and NY Waterway ferry service to/from Port Imperial Ferry Terminal beginning on February 1, 2016. Hudson Go Pass monthly passes go on sale at 5 p.m. on the 19th day of the preceding month and may be purchased through the 10th day of the month the pass is valid. Joint 10-trip tickets include 20 tickets - 10 for use on 156R, 158 and 159R bus service and/or Hudson-Bergen Light Rail and 10 for use on NY Waterway ferry service to/from Port Imperial to Midtown and Downtown Manhattan locations. Tickets used on Hudson-Bergen Light Rail must be time-stamped before boarding the train. Monthly passes do not need to be time-stamped. Children (ages 5-11) save 50 percent and up to three children (ages 4 and under) ride free with a passenger paying any valid fare. For student discounts, refer to the Student Tickets section. On weekends and holidays, up to two kids (ages 5-11) can ride free with a passenger paying any valid fare. In effect from 7 p.m. Friday (or the day before a holiday) until 6 a.m. Monday (or the day after a holiday). Students who attend post-secondary schools that participate in our University Partnership Program may purchase monthly student passes online and save 25-percent off regular monthly pass fares. Learn more. Elementary and secondary school students (through 12th grade) may travel for 33% off the adult one-way and transfer fares. To be eligible for this discount, students must reside in New Jersey and attend a public or accredited private or parochial school in New Jersey. Students must buy their one-way tickets prior to boarding the bus or obtain them from their school prior to travel. Student tickets may not be purchased aboard the bus. When purchasing one-way tickets prior to boarding, students must present a properly completed NJ TRANSIT Student Identification card issued by appropriate school authorities. Student tickets, sold 10 at a time, are available for purchase at most bus garages and at major terminals and are limited to not more than six sets of 10 student tickets of the same denomination to a student. Student tickets also are sold to Boards of Education and other appropriate school authorities on application to any NJ TRANSIT. Student tickets and transfers are valid for travel to and from all bus stops within the state of New Jersey. Student tickets are for personal use of the authorized student only. The student must present a valid NJ TRANSIT Student Identification card upon request by NJ TRANSIT personnel. Transfers are available to student ticket passengers for a continuing ride utilizing a second bus for a one-zone ride. A student presenting a transfer traveling through a transfer vending machine will be charged the applicable override fare. Senior Citizens (62 and older) and customers with disabilities can travel on NJ TRANSIT trains, buses, and light rail vehicles at a reduced fare of half the regular one-way fare or less at all times. Learn more. Military personnel and their dependents may use the one-way reduced ticket upon presenting their valid military or military-dependent ID cards. Eligible military personnel include Active Duty, Reserve and National Guard, and those with official "Retired" status from the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard. When purchasing your ticket from a ticket vending machine or through MyTix (an app), select Senior/Disabled to obtain the discounted fare. Tickets also may be purchased at ticket offices at stations. Veterans with service connected disabilities may present a valid Veterans Affairs (VA) identification card which indicates "service connected" to use the one-way reduced ticket option. Purchase monthly, weekly or one-way tickets including one-way reduced tickets (half fare or less) for senior citizens, children, passengers with disabilities as well as military personnel and their dependents through our Bus Sales program. A limited number of connecting routes offer continuing trip ticket privileges, which permit a customer to pay the entire one-way fare for a two-bus ride when boarding the first bus. The passenger receives a continuing receipt on the first bus, which is then accepted for travel on the second bus at an additional charge for a ride up to the number of zones shown on the receipt. The bus operator issues a continuing trip receipt to passengers paying a one-way fare or presenting a one-way ticket (adult, senior citizen, person with a disability, or child), or a ten-trip ticket. Continuing trip tickets are valid for two hours after issued and only when boarding the second vehicle at the connecting stop of the first vehicle. If a customer overrides, he/she will be charged for each additional zone. Transfers are available for use by one-way full-fare-paying riders whose complete trip must be made using two buses within New Jersey only. The transfer must be purchased at the time of boarding. Customers pay the regular fare to the transfer location, plus the transfer charge. The transfer will be accepted on the connecting bus for a one-zone ride. Riders going beyond one zone must pay an additional fare. Transfers are only valid for two hours after issued. On many bus routes, passengers are required to have exact fare in coins or \$1 bills. Drivers do not carry money and cannot make change. If you're a frequent rider, the ten-trip ticket and monthly pass are good alternatives to using exact change daily. To expedite the boarding process, customers departing Port Authority Bus Terminal are required to have a ticket or pass prior to boarding the bus. Please use ticket vending machines located throughout the Terminal or visit the NJ TRANSIT ticket office located on the main concourse level. Where to Buy A feature of the free NJ TRANSIT Mobile app, MyTix provides customers the convenience of buying and displaying bus passes and tickets securely from a mobile device. Download or update the app from the App Store™ and Google Play™. Commissioned Ticket Agents (CTA) are private retail businesses that sell NJ TRANSIT bus tickets or passes on our agency's behalf. CTAs can sell one-way (OW), round-trip (RT), ten trip (10T) or (10 ST) student tickets as well as monthly passes (MP) and tickets for senior citizens and passengers with disabilities (SC). CTAs are located throughout New Jersey, typically along NJ TRANSIT bus routes and nearby major bus boarding locations. To locate a CTA near you, access the county list, then locate the merchant by convention town listings that include the CTA name, address, and telephone number. Not all CTAs sell all ticket types, please take note to what type of ticket is sold at each CTA.
